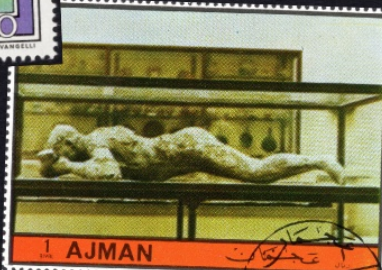
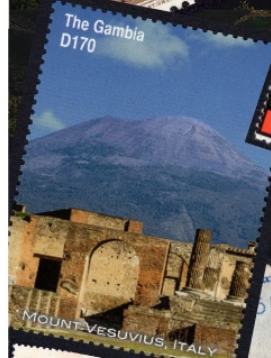
POMPEII



Pompeii is the world's largest archaeological site, covering 60 hectares at the foot of Mt Vesuvius



The initial Vesuvius eruption column reached 33km in height before collapsing on itself, creating pyroclastic surges that buried Pompeii



Archaeologists found empty spaces in ash layers, injected them with plaster and revealed people's positions where they died
